Parenting Tips

How Handwriting Trains the Brain

Studies do suggest there is real value in learning and maintaining the 'ancient' skill of handwriting, even as we increasingly communicate electronically via keyboards! Most schools still include conventional handwriting instruction in their primary-grade curriculum, but today that amounts to just over an hour a week.

Recent research illustrates how writing by hand engages the brain in learning. When writing by hand, you are crossing the mid-line engaging both sides of the brain; by manipulating a pencil and forming letters, it helps put the letter into memory. In a study there was more neural activity in the brain when letters were being written than in those who were simply looking at letters.

Legible handwriting will be essential as kids enter high school and start to prepare for college. Remember the essay portion of the SAT? Well, that portion still requires the essay to be hand written. If the essay is messy and cannot be read, the scorer will give it a '0'.

Children will be using technology, and it's important for teachers and parents to be familiar with it, but children (and adults) still need to be able to write, and someone needs to be able to read it.

We just ask that you advertise for the festival through your existing client list and any social media. The more people the better!



Here are the dates that I will be showing the Conscious Discipline program.


Start time is 6:30 pm for each session and FREE childcare will be available!
